We can even insert piping into wedges for more layering effects and use ghost wedges to fool the eye! You'll learn the Dresdens Over The Edge finish and a traditional finish so your quilts can be tailored to your preferences.

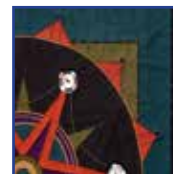

Payment: Payment is required with your registration in full for all classes plus a \$65 non-refundable registration fee. This includes one round trip ferry ticket and two horse drawn carriage tickets. If you have a spouse or additional guest attending that is not registering for classes; they are welcome to pay the \$65 registration fee to have their ferry ticket and carriage tickets held along with the group OR they can purchase their tickets independently at the time of arrival.
